North East England has an established track record of operating highly-efficient middle and back office functions, shared service operations and customer contact centres.

Why do businesses choose to locate their shared services operations in North East England?

- **Access to a flexible and multi skilled talent pool;** there are more than 132,000 people employed in the Business Services sector and over 43,000 university students studying relevant subjects, ensuring a constant flow of staff with financial, technical and administrative skills
- **Significant cost savings;** the region is one of the least expensive places in Europe to hire shared services staff yet the education, training and staff care are exceptional. Salary levels for a customer service representative are 14% less than London and 2% to 3% less than Scotland and Cardiff. Plus, Grade A office costs start from £5 per sq ft with Newcastle city centre rates 1/5th the cost of similar London properties
- **Plentiful supply of Grade A office accommodation;** City Centre locations plus out of town business hubs including

Quorum, Cobalt, and Doxford International Business Parks ensure shared service operations have plentiful office accommodation options to suit business needs

- **Superb connectivity;** Our business hubs have superb infrastructure links to the main A1 and A19 roads, major train stations as well as easy access to Newcastle International Airport. Many sites are linked to the Tyne and Wear Metro, the largest rapid transit system outside of London, helping ensure that skilled workers have easy access to their workplaces.

A loyal workforce

North East England's workforce has a reputation for being warm, approachable and confident. They are also flexible, adaptable and loyal, which is reflected in low staff turnover. In fact, the region has one of the lowest attrition rates in the UK for customer contact centre personnel at 12% (2015), 4% lower than the UK average.

The quality and standard of living in North East England remains one of the highest in the UK. The positive work/life balance experienced by staff results in unparalleled loyalty to both the company and the region.

Unbeatable skills availability

Over 100,000 students study at our five universities and more than 70% of graduates remain in the region after their studies.

This talent pool is well-skilled in digital and business innovation across a range of areas from languages, data analytics, business management and administration, enabling shared service businesses to recruit the right staff.

Colleges and universities in North East England work collaboratively with the private sector to deliver bespoke courses that meet the skills demand for the business services sector.

One third of all students in North East England study a business service related topic that is needed in the sector such as IT, accountancy, legal, and foreign languages.

This, combined with a high rate of overseas students provides a multi lingual workforce equipped with the skills required to operate a global business from the region.
